- Credit Requirements for the AS = 75 total credits, 39 NURS (18 LD & 21 UD), 36 cognate & gen ed credits.
- *Credit Requirements for the AS+RN-BSN* = 124-126 total credits, 66 NURS credits (26 from AS, 40 from RN-BSN), 27 cognates, 30-33 gen ed credits, NURS Electives to achieve 124 total credits.
- Credit Requirements for the **BSN Pre-licensure** = 124 total credits, 64 NURS, 27 cognates, 33 gen ed credits.
- Credit Requirements for the RN-BSN = 40 NURS credits (27 UD + 13 UD credits validated from level 4 for transfer students)
- Graduation Requirements: NURS GPA  $\geq$  2.7, Cognate GPA  $\geq$  2.0, Overall University GPA  $\geq$  2.5
- MATH 215 Waiver for both AS+RN-BSN and BSN Pre-licensure Majors (BSN if catalog is 2023 or later):
  - Math 215 Statistics is required for all students with a Math ACT < 22 or R-SAT < 540</p>
  - MATH ACT > 22 or R-SAT > 540: Take NURS 385 in lieu of MATH 215
  - Note: Electives (gen ed or NURS) may be needed to achieve the required 124 credits for a BSN degree.
- The AS Degree has Additional State Board Requirements for: CA, PA, OK, MI, VA, & NH
