Audio Recording Agreement

Audio-Recording Policy

In accordance with Subpart E of Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, a student with a qualifying disability which adversely affects his/her ability to take or read notes may be permitted to audio-record class lectures as a form of reasonable academic accommodation. Use of this accommodation is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Recordings of class lectures are only for the student's personal use in study and preparation related to the class.
- 2. The student may not share these recordings with any other person, database, or resource.
- 3. The student may not publish or quote the recording without the written consent of the lecturer.
- 4. The student agrees to return all recorded lectures to the lecturer or to DSS (if DSS provided the equipment for the student's use), or to destroy all recordings that were made when they are no longer needed for the class for which they were recorded.

I agree to destroy or return to the lecturer or DSS all recorded lectures by the end of the semester or when the recordings are no longer needed to complete their respective courses.
